INSIDE THE HERD

- Fresh off Thursday night's 68-64 win over Jacksonville, the Lady Bison continue home action on Saturday hosting North Florida, who will be looking to rebound from a 57-35 loss at Belmont.
- The Ospreys are one of the top defensive teams in the Atlantic Sun Conference holding teams to 62 points per game. Brittany Kirkland leads UNF in scoring averaging 12.3 ppg. Lakira Jones is a force on the glass for North Florida averaging 7.2 rpg.
- The Lady Bison hauled in a season-high 48 rebounds including 18 offensive boards and forced a season-best 21 turnovers in Thursday night's win against Jacksonville. Freshman post Sasha Robinson led Lipscomb with a dozen rebounds.
- Lipscomb junior wing Hannah Phillips continues to lead the way for the Lady Bison. The veteran is pacing the team in scoring (12.6 ppg), rebounding (5.1 rpg), assists (5.3) and steals (3.7) having scored in double digits in each of her past 11 of her last 13 games.
- With a 19-point night against USC Upstate, senior guard Anna Bowers became just the fourth Lady Bison to reach the 1,000 point milestone in the NCAA era. She joins her father Ricky, who notched 1,151 career points. Bowers ranks fifth among active A-Sun players in career points scored.
- The dean of the A-Sun in his 32nd year guiding the Lipscomb bench, Frank Bennett coached his 1000th career game last month against conference foe Mercer. Bennett is 581-429 (.575) all-time at Lipscomb and ranks 15th in wins among active coaches in Division I and ranks 26th all-time.
- Bowers and Phillips both head into Saturday's tilt having scored in 51 consecutive games. Phillips has played in all 81 games during her career at Lipscomb.
- Lipscomb is 2-0 when senior wing Leah McAlister scores in double digits.
- After just missing her first career double-double with a nine-point, nine-rebound effort against Gardner Webb to close out 2011, Freshman post Sasha Robinson posted an eight-point, 14-rebound effort against Jacksonville to open 2012. Robinson's 14 boards are not only a career high for the newcomer but a team high for an individual this season.
- The Lady Bison welcomed senior wing Leah McAlister back to the lineup against Mercer and the veteran paid immediate dividends scoring 15 points in only 17 minutes of action. The Lady Bison also got 18 points from Phillips.
- Lipscomb sophomore guard Haley Nelson posted her first double-digit game of her career against Air Force scoring 10 points that tied with senior forward Brittany Duerk for the team lead. Both players came off the bench against the Falcons as part of a 32-point night from the Lipscomb pine.
- Lipscomb freshmen Shanice Burnette, Sasha Robinson, Erika Thornsberry and Jana Wright each made their collegiate debut in the season home opener against Air Force.
- Continuing a tradition of community engagement, the Lady Bison have been very active in and around Nashville the last several weeks. In October, the Lady Bison joined thousands of other Nashvillians and participated in the Susan G. Komen Race for the Cure 5k held in the "Music City." Then in November, the Lady Bison traveled across town to Cameron Middle School to put on a clinic for the CMS students. The ladies worked with a number of CMS students and worked on basketball drills and fundamentals.
- After a 9-21, 6-14 A-Sun finish last season, the Lady Bison were tabbed to finish 10th in the league standings this season based on the voting in both the coaches and media polls conducted by the league.

LIPSCOMB WOMEN'S BASKETBALL HEAD COACH

FRANK BENNETT



The Greek word "arête" has many meanings, but the one that most fits Frank Bennett, the dean of the Atlantic Sun Conference, is "to be the best you can be."

Heading into his 32nd year as head coach of the Lipscomb Lady Bisons basketball team, Bennett has followed that philosophy. He preaches the importance of winning, but the mission of his program is to allow players and coaches room to grow spiritually, socially and academically.

Bennett's three-decade plus tenure is one of the longest in the history of the NCAA at one school. With an overall record of 577-415, and a .582 winning percentage Bennett ranks 29th in wins among all active NCAA Division I coaches.

During his tenure the Lady Bisons have been an NAIA national power, dealt with the transition period from the NAIA to NCAA Division I and appeared in the NCAA Tournament in the program's first year of eligibility, a history making feat.

Following the program's transition from NAIA to NCAA Division I, Bennett guided the Lady Bisons to the 2004 Atlantic Sun Tournament Championship in Dothan, Ala., and the NCAA Midwest Regional in 2004, marking the first time a Division I team has accomplished that feat in its first year of eligibility.

Reaching the NCAA's for the first time came right on the heels of Bennett claiming his 500th career win in a thrilling 66-65 victory Feb. 20, 2003 at Texas-Pan American. He has earned several additional distinctions during his career including:

- 2003 Atlantic Sun Conference Coach of the Year
- 2003 Division I Independent Coach of the Year
- 2002 selection to the NAIA Hall of Fame
- 1999 WBCA NAIA National Coach of the Year
- One of six finalists for the 1997 WBCA NAIA Coach of the Year
- 1997 TranSouth Conference Coach of the Year
- 1996 WBCA NAIA National Coach of the Year
- 1994 Tennessee Sportswriters Association College Coach of the Year
- 1986 and 1994 TCAC Coach of the Year
- Bennett produced All-America players the last 12 years in the NAIA and 13 out of the last 14 years the Lady Bisons were part of the NAIA.

Since he is equally concerned with classroom performance, nine Lady Bisons have been named All-America Scholar Athletes throughout Bennett's



coaching career. Each Lady Bison who has completed her senior year of eligibility has graduated.

In 2010, the Lady Bisons ranked ninth in NCAA Division I on the Women's Basketball Coaches Association 2009-2010 Top 25 Team Honor Roll. The Lady Bisons were the only A-Sun team to make the Honor Roll. Lipscomb compiled a 3.452 average. They were close behind DePaul in eighth place with a 3.455 average.

Before taking on the Lady Bisons program, Bennett served as head coach of the David Lipscomb High School girls' team. While at DLHS, Bennett compiled an impressive 109-23 record, including two straight state tournament appearances. In 1979, he was selected as Nashville Interscholastic League "Coach of the Year" after the team finished as TSSAA Class-A runner-up.

Bennett attended Lipscomb from kindergarten through college. He is a 1969 graduate of DLHS and a 1973 graduate of Lipscomb University. He earned two master's degrees from Middle Tennessee State University (1979) and the University of Evansville (1983).

He taught mathematics for three years and computer science for 17 years at Lipscomb University. When the school made the move to the NCAA Division I in 1999, Bennett stepped down from his teaching duties.

While in college at Lipscomb, Bennett lettered four years on the men's tennis team and was the assistant basketball coach for DLHS.

An admirer of the late UCLA coach John Wooden, Coach Bennett is the author of a children's book, *The Illustrated Rules of Basketball*. When he's not coaching, teaching or spending time with his family, Bennett enjoys weightlifting.

Bennett and his wife, Jan, have three children: Franklin (married to the former Reid Harrell), Lee (married to the former Aileen Wark), and Laura, who works at Lipscomb's Institute for Sustainable Practice. The couple also has one granddaughter, Lane, who belongs to Franklin and Reid.
